

**OGEFREM CIRCULAR LETTER DATED 30/04/08**

As from 30/04/08, FRABEMAR (in cooperation with its world wide agents network), has been appointed Mandataire of the Office de Gestion du Fret Maritime [OGEFREM [www.ogefrem.net](http://www.ogefrem.net)] to issue the FERI (Fiche Electronique des Renseignements a l'Importation) in all countries outside the DRC.

All importers must obtain a FERI at Port of Loading.

**Information Required**

The FERI must indicate:

- Exporters: name/address/phone/fax
- Importers: name/address/E. Mail
- Scanned copy of the B/L
- Name of the Company requesting the FERI
- Complete information regarding the carrying vessels POL/POD - ETS/ETA - Voyage number

For all transshipment cargo (same information)

- ISO Code of cargo
- Origin of goods
- IMO Class, if any
- Packages number and quality.
- Volume / gross & net weights
- Incoterm
- FOB value, sea freight base and accessories, insurance in USA\$ or Euro)
- Payment of the sea freight (Prepaid or To Collect).

**Tariffs**

The following tariff represent the amounts to be paid at POL (Compulsory)

- Euro 60.00 x 20' container
- Euro 110.00 x 40' container
- Euro 0.50 Freight Ton (T or M3 to OGEFREM advantage) – Bulk cargo of food products, pharmaceutical products, Mineral water and petroleum products)
- Euro 4.00 Freight Ton (T or M3 to OGEFREM advantage) General Cargo and RORO;
- Euro 50.00 x every FERI issued
