As you are already informed in our last letter Ref No KD 26/104/02/(15) of 22nd March 2010, please be reminded that you will be mandated to be submitting all Manifest in an XML format (which is the acceptable format compatible with Asycuda++) as soon as the System goes live on the 17th of June 2010.
